




We can distinguish the prey from the predator by looking for a time window in which a species goes down while the other increases. The increasing species will be the predator feeding on the prey, explaining the decay of the other.

In our case, graph B1 of question 1 illustrates this behavior : both curves slowly raise, until the green curve reaches a critical value, up to which it starts plummeting while the purple one soars
